History The PUG was established in 2007 after the publication in the newspaper Courier de l'Air of an essay by Konaté, a diplomat and previous candidate in the 2007 presidential election. Konaté accused President Lansana Conté of having been involved in a plot against his life. Konaté then called on the army to oust Conté and form a government of national unity with himself as the head. Later that year, the PUG signed a partnership agreement with the Popular Movement of the Revolution, another party led by Konaté, and claimed that it was the main alternative to the ruling Party for Unity and Development. Konaté and the PUG participated in the 2009 parliamentary elections, winning a single seat in the National Assembly. In the presidential election of 2010, the PUG again named Konaté as its candidate. A coalition of the PUG, the Rally for Democracy and Progress (RDP), the Congress for Democratic Progress (PCD), and other small opposition parties nominated Konaté over Moussa Dadis Camara, the President's son. Konaté won the election, with 42.5% of the vote. The PUG joined a coalition of opposition parties led by Konaté in January 2012. In July 2012, Konaté announced that he had decided to dissolve the PUG and join the United Front for Democracy and Progress (UFDG), which was becoming increasingly allied to the Rally for the
